PAPER PRESENTATIONS

A most essential part of the book fair is the event of paper presentation. The conference will be open to all. Any individual associated to any recognized university/organization/institution can take part in this event.

Objectives:

- To help the youth of India understand the need of hour and ponder overvarious issues in which technology plays a crucial role.
- To motivate the youth through their own ideas and papers to bring about a change with technology as a medium of this change.
- To seek solutions to the problems which can be sorted out using technology in which technology itself is a culprit.
- To provide opportunities to students/scholars to showcase their comprehensive knowledge and ability to explain it to a competent audience.

Event Format:

- Participants are required to submit the paper along with the abstract through mail by 25th Dec. 2023 on any one of the five topics.
- The selection of the multitudes of all the papers will be held in three stages.
- In the first stage the Abstracts will be reviewed and evaluated by a team of experts from higher institutions and around 20 abstracts will be selected for the evalution of their Paper.
- In the second stage, the papers of those 20 abstract will be evaluated by the tem of experts to select the top 10 papers on each topics. The top 10 participants will be informed by 05th Jan. 2024 of their selection.
- The top 10 papers on each topics will be printed in a National Journal as 21st Deoghar Book Fair 2024 special edition which will be released during the book fair.
- In the third stage, the top 10 selected presenters are required to make a PowerPoint Presentation along with their papers to present before the audience and judges at Deoghar Book Fair either virtual or physical as per the schedule.
- The presentation may be followed by a Q-A round with the judges.

General Rules:

- Word limit for the abstract (in word document): 350 words
- Word limit for the papers (in word document): 4500 words (Including graphics, tables etc.)
- The papers will be invited on topics based on the subthemes; a candidate can apply under any or all of the subthemes.
- Papers are to be original and should ultimately give a clear solution/methodology.
- Papers should not just be a review/assessment of an existing model/method/practice.
- Language to be used in abstract or final papers may be either in Hindi or English.
- Presentation Time (For round 3): 8 to 10 Minutes.
- The rules and all the word limits are to be followed seriously and failing to do so may result in disqualification.
